

International Scientific Practical Conference “Worldview basics and scientific proofs of Intelligent Design in Genesis of Life and Universe” has a purpose to develop scientific paradigm of Creation that would fully correspond with achievements in modern science and integrate these worldview issues to every segment of society.

At this conference the discussion will be raised on key controversial issues of the existence of modern society: origin of the world, origin of information and consciousness,

the border line between physics and metaphysics, modern geochronology, Biblical anthropology, the Spontaneous Evolution Theory and Creation Theory, teleology of the Universe, philosophical basics of Christian theism and the being of mankind, the problems of modern pedagogy, psychology, sociology, economy, ecology and ethnology.

The interplay between modern science and Christian theology, apologetics, as well as ethnic studies of Ukraine will be specially emphasized.

Scholars from Ukraine, Russia, South Korea, USA, Canada, Republic of South Africa and Scandinavia will take part in the conference. Among invited are scientists of leading fields of the exact and natural sciences, educational and human sciences, theology, representatives of management, culture, and various Christian denominations, graduate and postgraduate students, and others.

There will be plenary meetings and sessions.

Thematic plan of the conference:

SECTION 1 “Information Science, Physical and Mathematical Science” (physics, astrophysics, mathematics, logic, information science and cybernetics)

- Beginning of the Universe. Methodological and physical problems of its original substance.
- Bible and science. Physics and metaphysics.
- Principle of teleology in Universe and anthropic principle.
- Regularity and randomness.
- Principle of physical unity in Universe and cosmological hypothesis of its origin.
- Mathematical and physical proofs of Intelligent Design.
- Bible and logic.
- Role of worldview in science.
- Laws of origin and transfer of information.
- Are there “extra-terrestrial” civilizations?

SECTION 2 “Bio-Medical Science”

(biology, medicine, anthropology, psychology, bionics)

- Development of theory of biblical anthropology, “imprint” of the Creator in human beings.
- Problem of origin of life.
- Theory of predestinational systems as the theory of biblical theory of life.
- Connection of information and biology.
- Modern problems of biophysics.

SECTION 3 “Earth Physics”

(geology, paleontology, geochronology, ecology)

- Controversial issues of paleontology and geological stratification.
- Bible and ecology.

SECTION 4 “Humanitarian and Social Sciences”

(philosophy, psychology, pedagogy, sociology, history, civil law, ethics, economics, ethnic studies of Ukraine, and mass media)

- Philosophy, methodology and theory of science.
- Christian theism in light of philosophical ideas.
- Christian roots of Ukrainian morality. Ethnic studies of Ukraine.

- Principles of Biblical institution of family.
- The laws of governing and sociology: interaction of Church and State.

SECTION 5 “Theological Sciences”

(theology, Bible studies, systematical and practical theology, history of Christianity, ethics)

- Systematical and practical theology.
- Actual theological problems: existence of evil (theodicy), predestination or the freedom of will.
- Bible study, confirmation of credibility and prophetic power of the Bible.
